The member of public was concerned that the increase of resident's cars would create parking issues in Harkness Drive.</p> <p>4.</p> <p>A member of the public raised concerns over the amended Planning Application ZB24/02170/REM (Harkness Drive, Leeming Bar).</p> <p>A concern was raised that the amended application has been delegated to officials.
